Must be 18 years of age and must sign players waivers to participate, Guys and Gals

- Six players per team
- Helmets required equipment optional
- No Goalies or goalie equipment as No goaltending rule applies
- free agent players welcome as we have sponsors looking for players
- 4 v.s. 4 action
- Can only play on one team may substitute players if approved by organizer
- Absolutely no body contact (this will be monitored closely) penalties will be called
 - o no checking, minimal contact
- Fighting is under your control but will not be tolerated
- Two fifteen minute periods five minute period breaks
- Player waivers must be signed prior to play
- Game periods will start and end with sound of horn
- Each team will start one period with puck possession initiated by coin toss
- Losers clean ice with shovels for next game
- Cannot play if registration forms are not completed
- Format will be based on teams registered typically pool play, seeded championship bracket
- Action starts friday night with event meeting prior to tournament start Schedule will be posted soon.
- If in some cases team decide not to play their match they forfeit for a 1-0 loss
- The no delay in games does apply, if you are late for your match you will lose a goal a minute for the first five minutes after the fifth minute you forfeit the match for a 1-0 loss.
- Pool play points, win 2, tie 1, loss 0, Overtime win 2, Overtime loss 1
- Ties in Pool play 5 minute Head to Head, Goals against, Goals for, coin toss.
- Ties in Bracket play sudden death overtime
