





1. Polaris

65 Years ago, Polaris founders created an early snowmobile to better trail through northern Minnesota winters. Ever since, that same ingenuity to "Think Outside" has driven Polaris and their brands forward as a pioneer in the industry. Their state-of-the-art facility in Roseau is continually researching, developing, and manufacturing products to get people to work and play outdoors. As one of the largest employers in the area, Polaris continues to be a leader in their industry as well as a strong community supporter.

Z, Roseau School District

We are fortunate to live in a community that values and strongly supports education. In July of 2020, work began on a \$41 million construction project impacting over 133,000 square feet within our school. Nearly every area of the high school has undergone new construction or heavy remodeling as well as specific areas within the elementary school. The new architectural design and construction will transform how teaching and learning occurs, positively impacting today's students and students for generations

to come. Construction is scheduled to be completed in late 2022. Please call 218-463-2770 if you would like to tour our school or are considering enrolling your child.

3. MnDOT Highway 11 & 89 Improvements Roseau looks forward to practical and aesthetic improvements on the city's two major highway thoroughfares. The MN Hwy 11 project, scheduled for 2023, involves resurfacing the highway, better lighting

and sidewalks, and overall improved pedestrian facilities for a more walkable community. The MN Hwy 89 project, scheduled for construction in 2027, involves the complete reconstruction from a rural section to a suburban section with street lighting, roundabout intersection control, storm sewer, curb, gutter facilities and vastly improved pedestrian and bicycle safety through the provision of new sidewalks.

Gilbertson Field Project

One of the premier ball facilities in northern Minnesota, Roseau's Gilbertson Field has undergone impressive improvements including a new grandstand, press box, dugouts, fencing, concession stand, and a covered seating area for spectators along the left field line. The facility has hosted state and national youth baseball play-offs and will host the State Division II American Legion Tournament in Summer 2023.

5 Roseau River Water Trail Development

Located in the center of Roseau, South Riverview Park captures the city's vision of embracing and enhancing the Roseau River as an aesthetic and recreational amenity for the community. Recent improvements include a new fishing platform that enhances fish habitat around the access, a dock, a kayak/canoe launch platform and a new trail with interpretive signage. Future plans are to develop a Roseau River Water Trail from Hayes Lake State Park to Caribou Township, north of Greenbush, MN that qualifies for the "Greater Minnesota Trail" designation.

6. City Expansion and Housing Growth

The City of Roseau saw new expansion in 2021 with the creation of the new Oakcrest Estates Subdivision. Located on the southwest side of Roseau, the subdivision provides 36 new half-acre lots in and around the front nine of the Roseau Oakcrest Golf Course. A new 37-unit apartment complex was also initiated in the Oakcrest West Subdivision and 10 new home starts have been initiated in 2021 in the three Oakcrest Subdivisions. The new complex will be ready for occupancy in the summer of 2022.

7, Industrial Park Development

The Roseau Economic Development Authority (EDA) had a strong 2021 in its industrial park with the sale of seven lots and the proposed development of four new industrial facilities. Roseau County is constructing a new multi-million dollar highway department garage in the industrial park with completion in 2022. Other smaller industrial developments are also scheduled for completion in 2022.

6. 2021 Top 100 Critical Access Hospital

LifeCare Medical Center received this prestigious honor based on the Chartis Center for Rural Health Strength Index in the midst of the pandemic. From caring for patients in the emergency department, hospital and in their homes, to Covid testing and mass vaccination clinics led by LifeCare's Public Health department, LifeCare accomplished what needed to be done so community members could be cared for locally. With some of the most modern equipment and procedures available, working under pandemic conditions gave staff a new appreciation for each other, the work that other departments do, and how they can all work together to provide the best care possible. LifeCare supports two nursing homes, (Greenbush Manor and Roseau Manor), three Rehab facilities, (Greenbush, Warroad and Roseau), in addition to a hospital, Behavioral Health, Home Care, Hospice and Public Health. The Top 100 Critical Access recognition is a tribute to a dedicated staff focused on excellence while providing high quality care.









9. **Recreational Trail Expansion**

The City maintains over 12 miles of paved recreational trails and sidewalks throughout Roseau. Improvements include new trail signage including, marked walking and biking loops with distances, and a new pedestrian crossing over the Roseau Diversion where water once cut off a section of trail. The expansion on the north side of Roseau will provide a new pedestrian bridge and two blocks of new sidewalk across the Roseau River connecting two northern neighborhoods, recreational facilities and the Roseau Community School. The project is scheduled to be completed in 2025.

10 Business Growth and Retention is Strong in Roseau

Business growth and retention is at an all-time high in Roseau with the opening of a new Burger King, O'Reilly Auto Parts, Jiffy Lube, and many independently-owned businesses. Other well-established businesses invested in remodels. Roseau currently has 97% occupancy on downtown retail spaces and commercial lots around town are selling for new ventures. It's a great time to shop small and invest in our progressive community.

Memorial Arena, North Rink & Roseau Rams Sports Center

The Memorial Arena's 1940s wood frame arch structure provides a glimpse into the rich history of hockey in northern Minnesota. This old-school arena is equipped with upgraded mechanical compressor systems and rink components and provides full arena seating, sound system, scoreboard, locker rooms, and concessions area. The North Rink provides a second artificial ice rink, locker rooms, scoreboards, and heated/non-heated spectator viewing areas. A third artificial ice rink is located in the Rams Sports Center. These facilities help Roseau promote the betterment of the community for public skating and youth hockey activities.

Newly Remodeled Roseau County Museum

Established in 1927 to collect, preserve and disseminate Roseau County history, Roseau's historical society and museum share Roseau County's history through appealing museum exhibits, educational programs, and an extensive research center. Step back in time and learn all about early settlers and immigrants as well as the rich hockey history of the area.

Explore Roseau's Deep Polaris History

Take a self-guided wander through 5,600 square feet of the Polaris Experience Center. See the second snowmobile ever made and later innovations such as ATVs, Side-by-Side vehicles (SxS), motorcycles and more. Before arriving to Roseau, make a reservation for a tour of the Polaris plant.

A weekend celebration dedicated to summer, Roseau Fun Days are jam-packed with activities for the whole family. Crazy day sales, food trucks, and entertainment fill Main Avenue with plenty of outdoor games and activities at the city park and splash pad.


Diva Days

SNOWMOBILING

Big forests and vast prairies provide the perfect setting for snowmobiling! Trails open December 1st with over 300 miles of marked and groomed trails within Roseau County. The main "open" country trails connect all the towns within the county as well as the wilderness trails of Beltrami Island State Forest, Lost River State Forest, Kittson County, and Lake of the Woods County.

HAYES LAKE STATE PARK

Located on the edge of Beltrami Island State Forest, the park includes 3,000 acres of pines, miles of trails, a fishing pier, swimming beach, playground, and campground. Enjoy camping, hiking, biking, geocaching, swimming, fishing, canoeing, snowshoeing and cross country skiing. View rare birds such as Bald Eagles, Great Grey Owls, Sandhill Cranes and a variety of warblers. Wildlife includes elk, moose, bears, and wolves.

NEED GEAR?

Rent kayaks, sleds and bikes in Roseau at Riverview Outdoors and Recreation.

ATV

Thanks to the Roseau & Lake Of The Woods Sportsmans Club, there are plenty of opportunities to ride your ATV in Beltrami Island State Forest. Club volunteers maintain trails and the Roseau/LOW (aka Carp's Pit) recreational area just south of Roosevelt which marks the trail hub for 10 acres of land and includes a pavilion for picnics, restrooms, a warming shack, shooting range, and camping. The nonprofit club organizes various "runs" to complement the fishing and bird hunting openers and promotes youth hunting by sponsoring a family-friendly ruffed grouse hunt in October. Get an ATV map at area gas stations or the Chamber of Commerce. For more information, visit the club's Facebook page.



IN TOWN WARROAD HEAD TO THE LAKE

Automobile aficionados will want to stop at The Shed. Take a tour at the Marvin Visitor Center and the Warroad Heritage Center. Warroad Summer Theatre offers fine amateur theater. Get on the river or bike around town with equipment rentals from Doc's Harbor Inn and Doug's Supermarket. Try your luck at Seven Clans Casino. Hockey, golf, shopping, fishing, bird watching - there's something for everyone.

YOUR VACATION, YOUR AGENDA Go west go east

Located one hour west of Roseau, enjoy the drive through prairies, forests and farmland to Hallock. Check out the craft beverage scene in the only town in northwestern Minnesota to have a craft brewery, a craft spirit distillery and a wine bar. Attend the annual WhiskeyFest in November. On the way, stop at Lake Bronson State Park to enjoy some swimming, hiking, birding, and fishing.



Hit the water first thing in the morning and enjoy a day on the beach or go farther east to fish or paddle on the Rainy River. Fishing guides and launch services are available through many area resorts, providing all the equipment you need. They'll even clean your fish and provide a shore lunch. During winter months, rent a sleeper house and you won't miss a bite as you fish all night.





Head north from Roseau on Hwy 310 to the Lost River State Forest. This area is known for excellent birding, particularly for viewing great gray owls. Other birds in sight include snowy, northern hawk, and northern saw-whet owls; spruce grouse; whip-poor-wills; three-toed and blackbacked woodpeckers; yellow-bellied flycatchers; boreal chickadees; and magnolia warblers. As part of the greater Roseau River Wildlife Management Area, immerse yourself in wildlife and nature opportunities. Three snowmobile trails run through this forest offering some of the most remote wilderness trails in the state.



GO SOUTH

Hunters love all that Beltrami Island State Forest has to offer. Loaded with trails, this state forest is home to an impressive network of snowmobile trails that connect with a larger snowmobile trail system. Forest lovers can view the flora and fauna indigenous to the area while picking mushrooms and berries. Hayes Lake State Park provides camping, fishing and recreation such as swimming, geocaching and canoeing. Trails around the lake are great for hiking, biking, cross-country skiing and snowshoeing.

GO WAY NORTH

For those with an adventurous spirit - and a passport enjoy an excursion to the Northwest Angle. Passing through Manitoba (turn at Sprague), once you get up to the "chimney of Minnesota," you'll enjoy a quiet, back-to-basics vacation. Area resorts provide all your fishing gear and guiding as needed. Day trips on Lake of the Woods and to Kenora, Ontario can also be arranged. Check availability for lastminute trips. "Angle Days" are the first weekend of August. Laketrails Base Camp offers summer camps that gets kids on the trail, adult canoe trips and a rustic retreat for artists.

7. Riverbend Skate Path

In the midst of the pandemic in December 2020, a few Warroad community members living on the Warroad River came together to create a skate path to connect their two ice rinks. With school and sports canceled, interest in the path from the greater community grew and the path was connected to a public river rink at Doc's Harbor Inn. The neighbors, now dubbed the Riverbend Crew, received requests to extend the path which eventually became 2.26 miles. Locals wasted no time lacing up their skates and strapping on skis to try it out. The path gained national attention and was featured on *Good Morning America* and is now considered a winter destination for visitors.

Z, Yellow Rose Race

For 18+ years, the Yellow Rose Races have been a staple for runners and walkers alike. Each year, the race organizers choose a nonprofit organization to showcase and donate the funds raised by the race. The popular annual race has grown to include a 5K, 10K, virtual race, and a Race to the Rose Challenge that adds some friendly competition leading up to race week. In 2021, Yellow Rose Community Day was added to provide a chance for racers and community members to mingle and learn more about the community. It features a pasta feed as an added fundraiser. The racer organizers have high aspirations for the race events in the coming years. "There are plenty of people in the community who want good things for Warroad and are making that happen. The whole community makes what we have possible."

3, New Wellness Facility

Lifecare Medical Center and the Warroad Community Development team are working together to create a state-of-the-art wellness facility for Warroad. A portion of the project will be designated for Lifecare's Rehabilitation Center which will include Behavioral, Mental, and Physical Rehabilitation services. The other half of the facility will offer a fitness center, indoor walking path, community meeting facility, space for socialization, and a general-purpose room for programs like workout classes.

4. Northborn [™] Days/Northborn Music Festival

In 2021, Warroad launched Northborn Days – a two-for-one celebration of Allison Park and the Northborn Spirit that inhabits the people here. This multi-day event features a community picnic, singing competition, races, stations of Northborn activities and ends with the Northborn Music Festival – a full day of music from northern bands, ax throwing, yard games, beer gardens, food trucks, and more. The event takes place annually on the second weekend of June.



Marvin HQ & Employee Workspace Renovations

5, The New Liquor Store

The Warroad Municipal Liquor Store has been part of the community for over 80 years. The original store was built in 1941 at The Point near the lake. A new liquor store was built in 1972 and moved to the present location. Having outgrown its current space, renovations of the business begin in 2022. This rebuild supports the community's focus on being a regional destination and reflects more appropriately the growing vitality of the community. The business is expected to be open through the entire construction process.

Ø. Main Avenue Renovation Project

Warroad has a history of vibrancy in the downtown district. In 2019, Warroad Real Estate, LLC purchased four buildings on Main Avenue with plans for a mixed-use renovation in a way that blends the historic charm with a modern twist. The row of four buildings expects to be anchored with a restaurant, connected banquet space and outdoor patio seating. The remaining storefronts will be built to suit future businesses that lease the space. The second floor will have ten modern living quarters in a blend of 1-, 2-, and 3-bedroom market-rate apartments. Anticipated project completion is targeted for 2023/24.

In an effort to create new spaces that promote connectedness, creativity, and wellbeing, Marvin is renovating its facilities including its Headquarters and Operations spaces in Warroad. New workspaces, lunchrooms, recharge areas, restrooms, and outdoor spaces are updates underway across the Marvin campus. During warmer months, yellow bikes will be available for team members to use during breaks or to ride from building to building.

8. MnDOT Highway 11 Project

In 2020, MnDOT and the City of Warroad, with some assistance from Warroad Community Development, began planning the Highway 11 improvement project. The multi-faceted project includes plans to replace the aging bridge spanning the Warroad River, add a center turn lane on the other side of the bridge, resurface the entire corridor through town, incorporate two roundabouts to replace the existing stoplights, and add a multi-use trail to north/east side of Highway 11 all the way through town. The project will create a more walkable community with sidewalks or trails on both sides of Highway 11 and provide greater access to the downtown district. Construction on the project is set to take place in 2023.





9, Government Island


Warroad Community Development is working alongside the DNR to create a community park on Government Island. Located directly across from Lake of the Woods Brewing Co., the island has been cleared and cleaned of debris, and has already been host to an outdoor retreat. The goal for the future is to create a park-like setting that includes public docks, a sand volleyball court, green space for outdoor games, picnic tables, firepits, BBQ area, and a potential beach.

10, Advanced Resource Center

In 2021, Marvin announced the creation of an innovative partnership with Northland Community & Technical College to bring a mechatronics training program to Warroad. The Advanced Resource Center for Innovation and Education (ARC) allows students to earn up to a two-year Associate of Applied Science degree or any number of certificates within the 60-credit program. This first-of-its-kind education option provides a modernized, human-centered curriculum that enables students to structure their learning schedule around their individual needs and advance at their own pace through online learning and in-person skills assessments. The ARC and Northland partnership launches the mechatronics program in January 2022 with more programming to follow.

Norris Camp Loop

TRAILHEAD: Clear River Tower, 20 miles south of Warroad on CR5 DISTANCE: 65 miles ELEVATION GAIN: 700ft DIFFICULTY: Very difficult ROAD CONDITIONS: Gravel, soft sand at points, some asphalt CAUTION: Very isolated route. Bring enough supplies and GPS. Poor or no cell coverage. SIGHTS TO SEE: Clear River Observation Tower, former CCC Camp at Norris Camp, historic landing strip near Airport Trail Rd, moose, bear, wolves and berries. ROUTE: Go north 1 mile on CR5. Turn east (right). This road turns into Faunce-Butterfield Rd., then turn west (right). South of Norris Camp take Airport Rd Trail. At Hogsback/O'Brien Rd turn east (left). At Faunce Forest Rd., turn north (left). Faunce campground has a waterpump. This road turns into CR2 (asphalt). Go west (left) on Krull Trail. Stay west and go on Carps Trail until you are back to Roosevelt Forest Rd. Head north to retrace your steps to Bednar Trail, then south on CR 5 and back to Clear River.






Beltrami Island State Forest

Warroad is the gateway to Minnesota's second largest state forest. This huge forest has more than 138 miles of logging roads and many technical single-track paths to explore on your bike. Make sure you have a compass or GPS device. Exploring the low flatlands, peat bogs and ridges covered in pines, it is easy to get lost. Pass through the heart of blueberry country as you pedal along the forest roads. Along the way, you may see old foundations which are remnants from historic pioneer settlements.



Walking the Warroad business district seems like being dropped on the street half a century ago. People smile. They offer "Good Mornings." They help direct visitors to the sport shop, to the historic Olympic hockey arena, to the marina, to the new shops and motels being built.

It's also like the residents have been hired by the visitor's bureau. They want every new guest to have a great time.

One recent tourist said, "I always sped through Warroad on my way to Canada. With the border issues of the past two years, I finally stopped to smell the roses. Am I glad I ever did. My time at the sport shop was like being at a fishing seminar. That's why I go to Lake of the Woods. I learned about specific tactics, guides (always a good idea when fishing a new lake), where to fish, more about the variety of fish, and because of others in my party, some fun things to do. Like the shooting ranges. Fun. The museum was worth the time, and with parks and golf to stretch our legs after a long drive, our entire group agreed – Why go to Canada when it's all here?"

Warroad has become a beacon of light on the massive Lake of the Woods southwest shoreline. The small-town feel grows on folks. It sometimes feels like the media hype and attention of the big lake passes it by. That's okay for those who make it a destination. Especially those who want to combine fishing and family activities.

There is something for everyone. Hockey fans love the history. Hikers love the parks. Golfers love to play in the northwoods. What's not to love about the variety of restaurants? Or the many local fishing guides? Mostly, however, visitors love the fishing. After all, with the only American city settled on Lake of the Woods, the alluring water is captivating. That's why fishing is so highly revered in this quaint corner of Minnesota.

Lake of the Woods seasons are open 12 months of every year for the popular (and very large) yellow perch. Same with crappies and pike.

Walleye and sauger seasons remain open for 11 months, closing from mid-April to early May during spawning time. It's possible more "personal-best" muskies are caught on Lake of the Woods than any other lake.

Lake of the Woods USA waters comprise 317,000 acres. The southwestern shorelines and Muskeg Bay are favorite fishing destinations. In the clean sky-blue waters, perch, walleye, sauger and crappies cause mouths to water when thinking of these golden fillets.

Guides and charter captains know how to care for clients with large, well-equipped boats, gear and electronics to locate and catch fish. Being on the water every day clues them into patterns, removing the "where, what, how, when" questions for first-timers. Resorts send out fleets of boats daily during open water season or establish neighborhoods of ice shelters. Many resort packages include meals, lodging and fishing. That's why as many anglers fish and vacation here in winter as in the summer.

Websites describe ice conditions, travel recommendations (sometimes, resort tracked-vehicles are the only mode of transportation), and what's biting – walleye, saugers and perch.

Northern pike will also be caught under the ice. However, the fun begins when pike move into bays and shallows in late winter. As the bays finally shed ice, fun events like the Zippel Bay Ice Out Pike Tournament takes place. This is the official Warroad area open water fishing "opener."

Rivers produce massive fishing opportunities from ice-out to mid-April. The rivers provide 100-a-day-walleye catches this time of year. Spring time from walleye season opener through July is a fishing mecca on Lake of the Woods. Most anglers fish with salted minnows vertically below boats. Others vertically jig Rapala Jigging Raps or Northland Puppet Minnows. Some will rig with leeches or crawlers.


Bass and pike are lounging near the food. The weedbeds on the southwest corner of Lake of the Woods provide miles and miles of casting targets. Smallmouth bass may relate to weeds or the rock structures that litter the lake.

The Warroad region offers so many things to do that a break from fishing is often welcome. However, any day, any season could be the day that creates smiles while deciding where to put that trophy on the wall.



NORTHERNMOST POINT OF THE 42

The Northwest Angle offers an adventure you won't get anywhere else. Located on the northern side of Lake of the Woods, surrounded by Manitoba and Ontario, the NW Angle consists largely of gorgeous, undeveloped wilderness. Outdoor adventures include fishing, hunting, birding, cross-country skiing, snowshoeing, and snowmobiling with local volunteers grooming 132 miles of trails.

The village of Angle Inlet has several points of interest such as the last

one-room public school in Minnesota and the northernmost post office, 9-hole golf course, and point marker (located at Young's Bay) of the lower 48 states. Join the locals for "Angle Days" the first weekend of August. Historic sites at the NW Angle include Fort St. Charles, a restored 1732 French voyageur log fort and fur trading post; ancient native petroglyph called Painted Rocks: and Massacre Island.

Drive to the Angle through 40 miles of Canada or come across the lake



via charter boat, plane or bombardier. When arriving into the U.S. at the NW Angle, travelers will use the ROAM app located at most resorts or at the Custom and Border Protection's self-serve kiosks at Jim's Corner, the Church/School, or Young's Bay. Most angle resorts have an iPad loaded with a U.S. Customs and Border Protection check-in program.






